## When should I call LifeLink® for initial assessment of organ donation?

- Call within 60 minutes on ventilated patients, regardless of age, diagnosis, or sedation who meet ANY of the following:
  - Missing at least one brainstem reflex
  - GCS of 5 or less
  - TTM/hypothermia is initiated

## > Call back with updates if:

- Patient's condition declines
- Considering DNR/CMO/AND, withdrawal from life-sustaining measures, terminal extubation, palliative care, or hospice
- Family expresses understanding of poor prognosis, begins end-of-life discussions, or asks about next steps or donation
- Do NOT mention donation or "LifeLink" to family.
- If family asks what's next...state, "I have contacted someone to discuss the next steps and answer your questions."
- Refer all patients within 60 minutes of asystole for tissue donation, even if previously referred.





Remember: Wait, Don't Extubate! STOP
